Education that Multiplies Impact

At a cooperative sewing centre producing school uniforms for schools across the country, a PUM expert supported quality improvements and trained students in practical skills. Two years later, a follow-up project of cooperation strengthened the next group and helped improve workshop conditions. The ripple effect is clear: three former students have since opened their own boutiques, generating income and sharing their skills contributing to a vibrant local network of makers and entrepreneurs.
